

Frozen Snow Globes

Time: 15 minutes

What You'll Need

- Styrofoam ball - 2"-3" diameter, depending on the size of your jar
- Box cutter
- Canning jar
- Hot glue gun and glue
- Frozen figurine
- Glitter
- Ribbon

How To Make It

- 1 - Take your styrofoam ball and cut it in half with a box cutter.
- 2 - Place the halved ball on the lid of your jar. Scrape some styrofoam off the top if necessary to make a level surface for your figurine. Glue the styrofoam down to the lid.
- 3 - Screw the lid onto the jar and place a piece of tape on the lid in the direction that you want your figurine to face.
- 4 - Take the lid off and glue the figurine down facing the tape mark.
- 5 - Fill the jar almost to the top with water.
- 6 - Screw the lid onto the jar with water to test the water level. It should cover the figurines and almost fill the jar, but with a little extra room at the top.
- 7 - Remove the lid again, add glitter into the water, and stir.
- 8 - Put hot glue around the inside edge of the lid, and screw it on tight!
- 9 - Take the ribbon and glue it around the edge of the lid.

Notes

Cutting and gluing should be done with the aid of an adult.
